15 purchase three (3) 2025 Model Year Chevrolet Tahoes with selected options and safety
16 equipment for the Police Department from Tim Lally Chevrolet, Inc.

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF**
18 **WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:**

19 **Section 1:** That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to purchase three (3) 2025
20 Model Year Chevrolet Tahoes with selected options and safety equipment needed for the Police
21 Department from Tim Lally Chevrolet, Inc. as follows:

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22 **Section 2:** That the Director of Finance be and he is hereby authorized and directed
23 to issue warrants of the City of Westlake for said vehicle with safety equipment to the vendor
24 listed in Section 1 above in a total amount not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Twenty-One
25 Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$221,000.00).

26 **Section 3:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
27 concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
28 that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action
29 were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section
30 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised
31 Code.

32 **Section 4:** That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
33 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the
34 further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the efficiency and continuation of
35 services by the Police Department, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-
36 thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
37 passage and approval by the Mayor.
