Listed below are supplies that each child will need to begin the new school year.



We appreciate your support in providing these materials for your child, however, if you are unable to purchase any of these supplies, please contact our school counselor.

KINDERGARTEN (Please **do not** label supplies with your child's name unless specified)

- 1 set Headphones/earbuds, wired USB or 3.5mm (No Bluetooth) label with student's name
- 2 boxes Crayons, 24 count small
- 1 box Colored markers (water based, 8 pack)
- 3 Primary #2 pencils with eraser (these are the thick pencils)
- 3 #2 pencils
- 1 pair Children scissors (5 inch, with a blunt, not pointed end)
- 6 large Glue sticks (solid – not liquid glue sticks)
- 4 Dry erase markers - color: black (low odor, thin points)
- 1 Dry eraser
- 1 Playdoh- one color
- 1 Plastic folder with 2 pockets -label with student's name
- Extra clothes in a zip lock bag, labeled with student's name

Optional but also appreciated: roll of paper towels, stickers,
box of plastic zipper closure snack, sandwich or gallon sized bags, box of tissues,
Personal reusable water bottle- label with your child's name- must be able to close to prevent spills

1st GRADE (Please label all supplies with your child's name)

- 1 set **Headphones/earbuds**, wired USB or 3.5mm (No Bluetooth)
- 1 Large durable zippered pencil pouch (no pencil boxes)
- 1 doz. Pencils (no mechanical pencils) --**please sharpen**
- 5 Dry erase markers, black or blue preferred
- 1 pkg. Colored pencils (12 count)
- 1 box Crayons (no more than 24)
- 1 pair Children scissors (5 inch)
- 6 Glue sticks
- 1 Eraser, large
- 1 Dry eraser or clean sock
- 3 **Primary Marble** composition books
- 1 1 –inch 3-ring binder (any color for writing portfolio)

Optional but also appreciated: **2 boxes of tissues**, 25 clear sheet protectors for writing portfolio

2nd GRADE (Please label all supplies with your child's name)

- 1 set Headphones/earbuds, wired USB or 3.5mm (No Bluetooth)
- 1 Large durable zippered pencil case or zip lock bags (no pencil boxes)
- 24 Pencils, please sharpen (no mechanical pencils or pop-out points)
- 1 Highlighters, yellow preferred
- 6 Dry erase markers (low odor, thin points, all black preferred)
- 1 Dry eraser or clean sock
- 1 box Crayons (no more than 24)
- 1 pair Scissors (5 inch)
- 6 Glue sticks
- 4 Folders, plastic preferred with 3 prongs & pockets (1 green, blue, red, purple preferred)
- 6 Marble composition books (**wide ruled, no college ruled**)
- 1 Spiral notebook, wide ruled

Optional but also appreciated: 3 packs of sticky notes (MOST wanted for the Reading & Writing curriculum), box of tissues, roll of paper towels, 1 pack plastic sheet protectors, colored copy paper, colored cardstock, construction paper

3rd GRADE (Please label all supplies with your child's name)

- 1 set Headphones, wired with a 3.5mm jack (No Bluetooth)
- 1 Large durable zippered pencil case (no pencil boxes)
- 24 Pencils (No. 2, no mechanical pencils)
- 1 pkg. Colored pencils or crayons (12 count)
- 2 Highlighters
- 1 box Plastic sandwich size zip bags (Only students with last name beginning A-L)
- 1 box Plastic gallon size zip bags (Only students with last name beginning M-Z)
- 4 pack Dry erase markers (low odor, black or dark color preferred)
- 1 Dry eraser
- 1 box Crayons (24 pack)
- 1 box Washable markers (8 pack)
- 1 pair Scissors (5 inch)
- 6 Glue sticks (large size preferred)
- 2 packs Loose leaf paper (wide rule)
- 7 Folders, plastic preferred (with 3 prongs and pockets, No binders)
(Preferred colors: 1 red, 1 orange, 1 green, 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 purple, 1 black)
- 8 Marble composition books (**wide ruled, no college ruled**)



Optional but also appreciated: 2 boxes of tissues, disinfecting wipes, 3 pks. 3"x3" sticky notes, 2 pks large sticky notes, 1 set of 25 sheet protectors, 1 ream printer paper, bright color printer paper (ex. Astrobrights), heavy duty 11 x 14 paper tray to carry books from class to class (ex. Lakeshore, see above)

4th GRADE (Please label all supplies with your child's name)

- 1 set Headphones/earbuds, wired USB or 3.5mm (No Bluetooth)
- 1 pkg. Sharpened pencils (No. 2) *NO mechanical pencils
- 2 Pens, blue
- 2 Pens, red
- 2 Highlighters
- 1 box Crayons or colored pencils, 24 count (no more than 24)
- 4 Dry erase markers (low odor, thick points preferred)
- 1 pair Scissors (7- or 8-inch student)
- 8 Marble composition books (**wide ruled, no college ruled**)
- 1 Pencil case
- 2 Glue sticks, large
- 6 Folders with 3 prongs and pockets - do not label (No binders)
(1 orange, 1 green, 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 purple or black preferred colors)



Optional but also appreciated: 4 pks. 3"x3" sticky notes please, box of tissues, 1 Stylus, hand sanitizer, heavy duty 11 x 14 paper tray to carry books from class to class (ex. Lakeshore, see above)

5th GRADE (Please label all supplies with your child's name)

- 1 set Headphones/earbuds, wired USB or 3.5mm (no Bluetooth)
- 1 Large, zippered pencil case (no pencil boxes)
- 24 Pencils (No. 2)
- 1 pkg. Colored pencils or crayons (24 count)
- 4 Highlighters
- 12 Dry erase markers (low odor, thick points preferred)
- 1 Dry eraser or Clean Sock
- 1 pair Scissors (7 – 8-inch student scissors)
- 8 Glue sticks
- 7 Marble composition books: **wide ruled, no college ruled, no spiral**,
(red, blue, green, yellow, orange, purple, black colors preferred) for the different subjects
- 7 Plastic folders with **pockets**
(1 red, 1 blue, 1 green, 1 yellow, 1 orange, 1 purple, 1 black preferred colors)

Optional but also appreciated: Boxes of tissues, box of plastic zipper closure sandwich, quart or gallon sized bags
