Things to know:

1. Grant applications are due on or before July 15th.
2. Projects must be completed by May 1st. Grant recipients must submit a final, detailed evaluation report to the Foundation via email no later than May 7. Failure to do so will automatically exclude the recipient from future grants.
3. Grant requests from a minimum of \$100 up to a maximum of \$750 will be accepted. Any request above \$750 will be considered on a case by case basis.
4. Projects must directly involve students, demonstrate sound educational values, and have well-defined goals.
