

# KISD Schools Earn Honor Roll Status

Killeen ISD's Early College High School, Skipcha Elementary School and Richard E. Cavazos Elementary School made the Texas Honor Roll for 2024, according to the Educational Results Partnership.

The 10th edition of the Lone Star State's top-performing schools includes 63 school districts and 762 individual schools from across Texas.

The three KISD schools are part of the top 12 percent of eligible schools, according to the non-profit ERP that recognizes high-performing schools able to close achievement gaps, especially among high-poverty and historically disadvantaged populations.

Honor Roll schools are recognized for demonstrating consistently higher levels of student achievement, improvement in achievement over time, and a reduction in achievement gaps among student populations.

"ERP is all about improving educational equity and promoting career readiness for all students, regardless of family income, background or ZIP code," said ERP Chief Executive Officer James Lanich, in a press release.
