* SUPERIOR PROGRAM: We are competency based and provide ample opportunities for students to be successful both in the classroom and Behind-the-Wheel. All instructions are provided by certified teachers with Traffic Safety endorsements. One instructor has a Special Education endorsement to further assist students that need extra help and time.

* CONVENIENT: Classes are held after school at the High school site. Classes: 3:00-4:30pm. (1st-4th quarters), 8:00-10:00am. or 11:00-1:00pm. (summer). Drives: 3:00-5:00pm. or 5:00-7:00pm. (1st-4th quarters), 8:30-10:30 or 10:30-12:30pm. (summer).

* FLEXIBLE: Five (5) sessions to choose from: These dates are tentative at this time.

1st Quarter dates: Sep. – Nov.

2nd Quarter dates: Nov. – Jan.

3rd Quarter dates: Feb. – Mar.

4th Quarter dates: Apr. – Jun.

Summer Session dates: Jun. – Jul.

Monday/Wednesday classes, or Tuesday/Thursday classes for 8 weeks

(1st-4th quarter), Mon.-Thu. (8:00am-10:00am or 11:00am -1:00pm.) For 5 weeks (summer).

* COMPETITIVE PRICES: \$650: For interested families, there are two Payment Plans available to choose from.

* WE WORK WITH FAMILIES TO HELP STUDENTS BE SUCCESSFUL: We provided many opportunities to make up tests and absences. We provide 30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of driving instruction plus 6-12 hours of driving observation to assure competency. In addition, there will be 50 hours of driving practice at home. All of this time equates to receiving a 0.5 credit (1 semester class credit).
