2025 – 2026 Vehicle Parking Contract
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!



Parking a student vehicle on the Arlington High School campus is a privilege. By issuance of a permit, the Arlington School District and/or Arlington High School does not assume liability for any property damage to any private vehicle parked on its property. As such, AHS students are encouraged to use district-provided transportation.

Arlington High School is a closed campus. Students may not leave campus without an office-issued note and parent permission.

Students driving vehicles to AHS will be required to adhere to the following:

1. Parking passes are available to seniors and juniors only. Students must have a current permit when parking on campus. The cost of a parking permit is \$50.00 per year. To receive a permit, students must present proof of insurance and a valid driver's license. **THE PERMIT MUST BE VISIBLE AT ALL TIMES ON THE LOWER PASSENGER SIDE WINDSHIELD OF THE VEHICLE. *If pass is not visible, you will not be allowed to park on campus or subject to a fine. If driving a different vehicle for any reason it's your responsibility to switch your parking pass. (Included but not limited to car in shop, car accident, etc.) Liable for a fine if not communicated.***
2. To discourage truancy and to protect student vehicles from possible theft or vandalism, the parking lot is closed to students during the school day. Do not use your car as a locker; remember all supplies and bring them with you into school when you arrive each day.
3. Students may not possess and/or use a permit that belongs to someone else; selling or giving a permit to another student is not allowed.
4. Students who did not ride with you to school may not hang out in your car, nor may any student who does not self drive come to your car to hang out.
5. Students may not park at any time in spaces marked for staff or visitors.
6. Parking in handicap spaces, fire lanes, on sidewalks, or on grass areas, etc. are in violation of AHS parking regulations.
7. Students are responsible for the cleanliness of the area in the immediate vicinity of their vehicle. Litter must be kept in vehicle or placed in a garbage can.
8. In terms of student conduct rules, possession of alcoholic beverages, cigarettes, vaping or e-cigarette devices, drugs and/or drug paraphernalia, firearms, or a dangerous weapon shall extend to a student's vehicle.
9. School officials have authority to maintain order and discipline in schools as well as to protect students from exposure to illegal drugs, weapons, and contraband. To this end, school authorities may inspect or search places and areas such as parking lots and vehicles parked in school parking lots without consent of the student and without a search warrant.
10. Parking on campus without a permit will result in a violation as follows:

1 st offense:	\$50.00 ticket, placed on fine list in the office
2 nd offense	\$60.00 ticket, placed on fine list in the office
3 rd offense:	\$65.00 ticket, placed on fine list in the office, student will be unable to purchase pass and car may be towed at owner's expense
Improperly parked	\$50.00 ticket, placed on fine list in the office (taking up 2 spaces, embankment, sideways, etc)
Last years sticker	\$50.00 ticket, placed on fine list in the office
