

RESOLUTION NO. 25-08
Public Access to School District Records

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Arlington School District No. 16, Snohomish County, Washington, is committed to providing the public full access to records concerning the administration and operations of the District in compliance with Chapter 42.56, RCW, otherwise known as the Washington Public Records Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes that the District continuously generates a tremendous volume and diversity of records; and

WHEREAS, attempting to maintain a current index of such records would be impracticable, unduly burdensome, and interfere with the District's operations and essential function of providing a public education to Washington's youth. The District continuously generates a tremendous volume and diversity of records that are related to and stored in numerous elementary schools, middle schools, high schools, and various other administrative facilities and departments. Due to the District's limited staff resources, the voluminous amount of documents associated with District functions, and the diverse, complex records stored in multiple locations and in multiple databases, there is not one complete records index that is available for review.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Arlington School District No. 16 will not maintain a current index of its records and that a copy of this Resolution will be made available upon request.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that execution of this Resolution is conclusive evidence of the Board's approval of this action and of the authority granted herein. The Board warrants that it has, and at the time of this action had, full power and lawful authority to adopt this instrument.
