

APS DISTRICT STUDENT ADVISOR OPPORTUNITIES

ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR EDUCATION (ACE) - GRADES 6-12

- Student Advisors would provide a student's perspective on educational decisions and study/research topics identified by the Board of Directors
- One-year commitment with the option to renew for another year
- Meets from 6:00 - 7:30 pm once a month, usually on Thursdays, at the district office
- Student Advisors automatically become SAC members

BOARD OF DIRECTORS - GRADES 11 & 12* (*2025-26 ONLY)

- Student Advisors represent the students of the district through communication with the Board of Directors, contribute to Board discussions, provide advisory votes, when appropriate and serve as liaison for the ASB regarding Board deliberations and actions
- **One-year commitment beginning your Senior year***
- Two-year commitment beginning your Junior year
- Meets for regular meetings on Mondays, generally twice a month, at 6:00 pm and special meetings/study sessions, generally ten times a year at 4:00 pm at the district office and an all-day workshop in August
- Student Advisors automatically become SAC members

BUDGET ADVISORY TASK FORCE (BATF) - GRADES 6-12

- Student Advisors will increase their understanding of school district finances, public school funding and education learning needs and provide feedback regarding budget priorities and make recommendations to the Superintendent
- One-year commitment with the option to renew for another year
- Meets from 6:00 - 7:00 pm, usually on Tuesdays, no more than once a month or once a quarter depending on the district's finance planning needs
- Student Advisors automatically become SAC members

DISTRICT COMMUNITY EQUITY TEAM (DCET) - GRADES 6- 12

- Student Advisors would provide input and feedback regarding the implementation efforts of the district equity plan, support the elimination of inequities and disparities in student achievement and fostering a safe and healthy school climate
- One-year commitment with the option to renew for another year
- Meets from 5:30 - 7:00 pm, usually on Wednesdays, once a month via Zoom
- Student Advisors automatically become SAC members

APS DISTRICT STUDENT ADVISOR COMMITTEES

FACILITIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE (FAC) - GRADES 6-12

- Student Advisors participate in the review of the district's instructional and support facilities to gauge their adequacy in supporting the safe, equitable delivery of instructional services and make recommendations to the Superintendent
- One-year commitment with the option to renew for another year
- Meets from 6:00 - 7:30 pm no more than once a month or once a quarter depending on the district's pending projects, usually on Thursdays, at the district office
- Student Advisors automatically become SAC members

STUDENT ADVISORY COUNCIL (SAC) - GRADES 6-12

- Student Advisors meet to share their voices/perspectives and ideas, engaging in authentic conversations to better support a rich and caring learning environment where each student learns at high levels and belong
- One-year commitment with the option to renew for another year
- Meets from 6:00 - 7:30 pm once a month, usually on Wednesdays, at the district office

SPECIAL ED ADVISORY COMMITTEE (SEAC) - GRADES 6-12

- Student Advisors will participate in a collaborative forum with parents, guardians, and school staff to support and advocate for the needs of students receiving special education services in Arlington
- One-year commitment with the option to renew for another year
- Meets from 6:00 - 7:30 pm quarterly, usually on Tuesdays, at the district office

TECHNOLOGY ADVISORY COMMITTEE (TAC) - GRADES 6-12

- Student Advisors will provide various perspectives, experiences, and honest, constructive feedback regarding the District's technology program
 - One-year commitment with the option to renew for another year
 - Meets from 4:00 - 6:00 pm once a month at the district office
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
