

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR PARK AND PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITIES

The parties to this agreement are the CITY OF ARLINGTON, WASHINGTON, a municipal corporation of the state of Washington (hereinafter "CITY"), and ARLINGTON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 16, a municipal corporation of the state of Washington (hereinafter "the District"). The parties are entering into this agreement based on the provisions of RCW 39.34, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, RCW Chapter 39.34.

RECITALS

~~WHEREAS, both parties are parties to two interlocal agreements dated May 28, 2002,~~
 one entitled "INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR COMMUNITY PARK AT PIONEER
 ELEMENTARY SCHOOL" and the other entitled "INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR
 FORMATION OF A JOINT OPERATING COMMITTEE"; and

WHEREAS, both agreements were administered by a Joint Operating Committee ("JOC") comprised of one elected official and one staff member from each entity, and the chairperson of the City of Arlington Parks, Arts & Recreation Committee ("PARC") as the fifth representative; and

WHEREAS, the parties are supportive of the work which the JOC committee has performed to date; and

WHEREAS, both parties believe that their cooperative work has been beneficial to the taxpayers and wish to continue to explore additional opportunities for sharing resources; and

WHEREAS, the expansion of the work of the committee will require additional members, and the parties wish to change the composition of the JOC committee to reflect that expansion;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do agree, as follows:

1. Paragraph 6 of the interlocal agreement dated May 28, 2002, entitled "INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR FORMATION OF A JOINT OPERATING COMMITTEE" shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

The Joint Operating Committee is charged with the responsibility for determining operational rules and requirements, addressing unforeseen contingencies, and annually reviewing the equitable allocation of responsibilities, including

maintenance under this agreement. The Joint Operating Committee shall be composed of one staff member and two elected officials from both parties and a seventh member selected from the CITY's Parks, Arts, and Recreation Commission. The Parks, Arts, and Recreation Commissioner shall act as the chairperson of the JOC.

2. Paragraph 6 of the interlocal agreement dated May 28, 2002, entitled "INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR COMMUNITY PARK AT PIONEER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL" shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:
