The Board does not respond to questions during the business meeting in order to comply with the State of Washington's Open Public Meetings Act. The Board's silence does not signal agreement or endorsement of the speaker's remarks.

The Board will receive comments only during the designated *Public Comment* time on the agenda. You may address the Board on any topic within the scope of the Board's responsibility. The Board President may interrupt or terminate an individual's statement if it is uncivil or exceeds the allowed time. Each speaker will be given one opportunity to speak.


Depending on the nature of your topic or questions, the Superintendent may ask staff to contact you to answer questions or provide information. If you requested a follow-up response on your Public Comment Form, you will typically receive a response within five (5) business days, depending upon research required.
