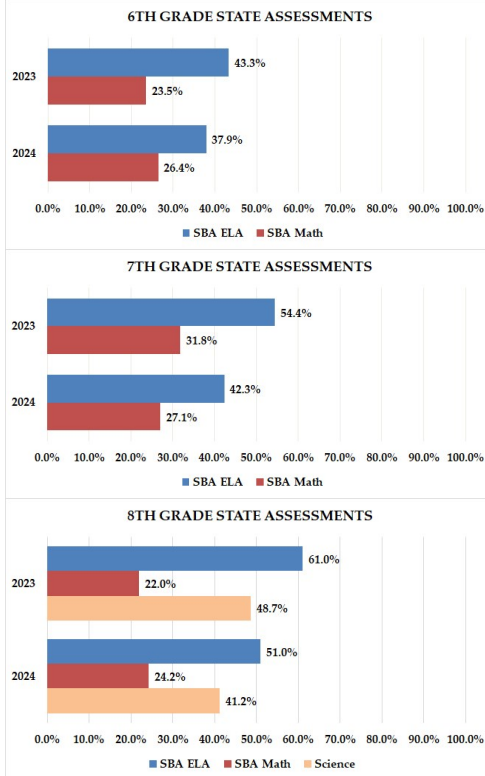

Facility Use

Haller Middle School opened in September 2006. The school was constructed on the site where Arlington High School was located from the 1930s to 2002. In order to build Haller, many of the former high school buildings were demolished. Exceptions to this were the gym and music buildings that were remodeled and incorporated into the new school. The new portion of the school was connected to the remodeled gym and includes a commons, administrative offices and a two-story classroom wing. Haller's campus includes a courtyard area, outdoor classroom, baseball/softball fields, soccer/football field with grandstands, lights and a track. You are invited to become an active part of our school.

School Improvement Plan

For the 2024–2025 school year, Haller Middle School will focus on three main areas to support student success: MTSS (Multi-Tiered Systems of Support), attendance, and Social Emotional Learning (SEL).

MTSS: Haller will follow a three-tiered support plan: Tier 1: Grade-level teams will meet monthly to identify and support students needing basic interventions. Tier 2: The Child Study Team (CST) will meet monthly to help plan next steps for students needing additional support. Tier 3: The Multidisciplinary Team (MDT) will support students who need intensive, individualized help.

Attendance: Haller aims to increase student attendance from 64.92% to 74.92% this year.

SEL: Haller will continue using the Character Strong curriculum to support student well-being. Grade-level and all-staff meetings will be held monthly to review and adjust the curriculum based on student needs. Surveys will be used to gather feedback from students and staff throughout the year.
