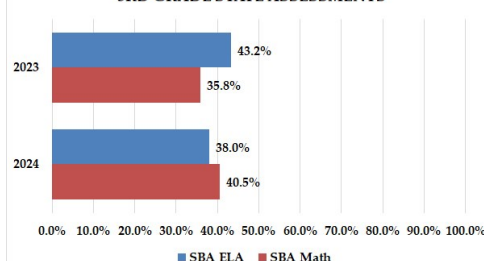

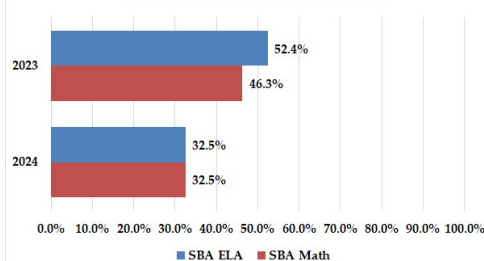
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## Student Assessment Result Comparisons

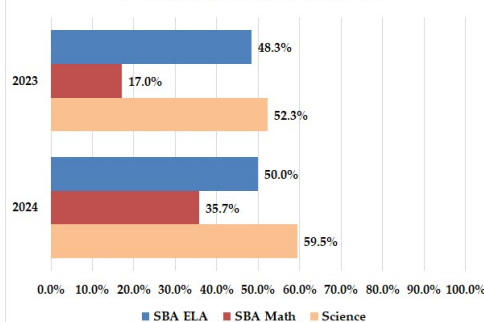
3RD GRADE STATE ASSESSMENTS

## Facility Use

Pioneer Elementary opened for the 2002-03 school year. This two-story elementary school houses 31 classrooms for use as kindergarten through fifth-grade classes, music, art, technology, special education and remedial programs for both math and reading. The facility also includes a multi-purpose room with a stage for use as a gymnasium, lunchroom and for assemblies and events. A 2020 Capital Levy funded the installation of a secured entryway at Pioneer. The school received a new roof and paint in Summer 2024. You are invited to become an active part of our school.

## School Improvement Plan

During the 2024-25 school year, Pioneer Elementary has been dedicated to increasing math achievement by integrating UDL into tier one math instruction. This has been done through:

- Focusing on math standards, implement 3 Act Tasks and math games into math instruction.
- PLC's use of the 4 questions, use of common formative assessments, and data cycles that drive the next steps for instruction.
- Increase student attendance to 90% or greater.

Student success is measured by STAR, SBA, and other curriculum based measures.
