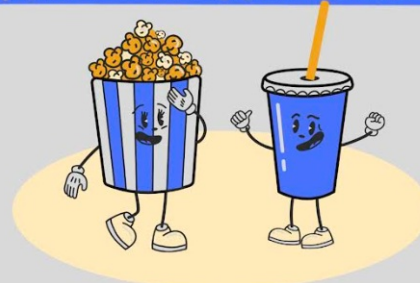

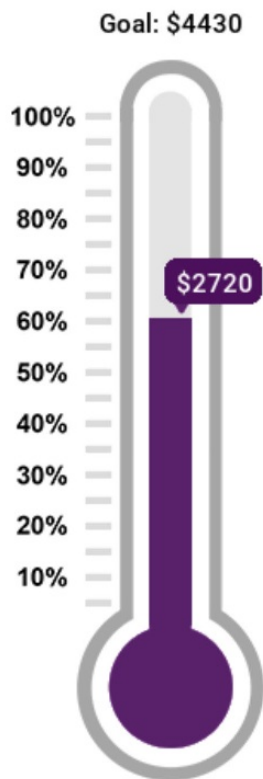
The read-a-thon is ending tomorrow so don't forget to log your student's minutes.
