- Smart Watches on Campus: As part of our ongoing efforts to maintain a focused and respectful learning environment, we'd like to remind everyone about the use of smart watches during the school day.
- Smart watches are allowed on campus but should be used solely as timepieces, not as phones. If a student is using their watch for texting or other phone-like functions, we ask that they place it in their backpack, in line with our cell phone policy. This helps ensure that students remain engaged in their learning without distractions.
