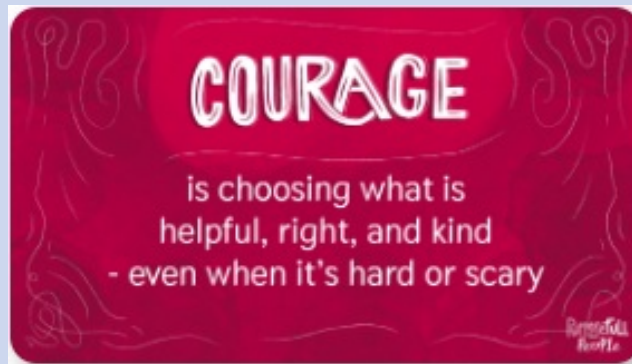

Sixth grader Charlotte said, "She is in a happy mood almost always, so she sets the vibe, so everyone is in there having fun. Sometimes she has to be serious, and we have to leave because we are being too loud or something. But always she is funny and kind."

Fourth grader Aria agrees. "She lets us take our time when we ask questions. And she usually talks with us about school and how it's going. She shows us respect." Katie, a fifth grader, shared a similar memory when thinking about Tiffany. "On my first day of school when I came into the office she said, 'Make sure to say hi to me!' She's the first person I knew here, and she feels like family to me. Also, my mom really likes her because she is nice and has a nice personality. She really relates to our family; she has kids, and I have 5 siblings. We talk about our families a lot and we share."

"Family" is a great way to describe the tone at SVLC, so much so that Katie gushed, "She kind of reminds me of my mom... she doesn't lie, she is really kind. She is nice to everybody. She has the same personality for every student— if they are nice, she is nice, and if they aren't nice, she is still nice. Consistent. She keeps really good secrets, too.... She doesn't blabber what we talk about all over."
