



Personal Electronic Device Policy

In order to minimize and eliminate classroom distractions during instruction, the following will be implemented for the 2026-2027 school year:

- **As per HB 1481, personal electronic device usage will not be allowed during instructional hours.**
 - Elementary 8:00 am - 3:45 pm
 - Secondary 8:00 am - 4:00 pm
- **Personal electronic devices are defined as, but not limited to cell phones, smart watches, fitness trackers with texting/calling capabilities, bluetooth earbuds/headphones, gaming devices, tablets and personal laptops.**
- **During the instructional day, personal electronic devices must be turned off and remain in district approved storage.**
- **If students need to make an emergency call, they may use the school phones located in the office and classrooms.**
- **Students may be subject to disciplinary action for possession and/or use of personal electronic devices throughout the instructional day.**
- **The school and its staff are not responsible for any damage to or theft of a student's personal electronic device.**
- **Students, including dual credit students, will not be able to use any type of personal computing device during instructional time. San Diego ISD will provide all students with a district issued device.**
