

	<u>2026-2027 Dress Code</u> Acceptable Dress	Special Comments And Interpretations
Shirts Blouses	• Polo style in Royal Blue • Shirts must be tucked in at all times and with a belt (Grades 3-12). • Name monogramming and school logo must be in Gold or White. (School logo is optional) • Spirit shirts may be worn only on Fridays. • Spirit shirts must be Royal Blue, have school colors, designs, and acceptable logos. • Homemade Spirit shirts must be approved by the Campus Principal. (Must be Royal Blue) • College shirts may be worn on Thursdays.	• No display of undergarments. • No oversized shirts. • Shirts may not be bleached. • Students who cannot tuck in their shirt for medical reasons must provide the office with a doctor's excuse before being allowed to do so.
Sweaters, Jackets & Coats	• All jackets/sweaters must have full or half zippers or buttons without hoods and may be in any color. • No offensive or distracting logos or messages on sweaters and jackets.	• No hoodies allowed (pullover or zipper). • No trench coats allowed. • No military type of camouflage. • Sweaters, jackets, or coats sold by school organizations must be approved by campus or district administration.
Pants Slacks	• Pants must fit appropriately and adequately at the waist and crotch. • They must have belt loops and a belt is required for Grades 3-12. • Uniform style khaki pants and jeans can have no more than five pockets. • No torn or frayed jeans allowed. • Blue jean shorts, uniform style khaki shorts, skorts, dress jumpers, blue warm up & capris are allowed at elementary school only (Shorts, skorts and skirts must be no shorter than 3 inches below the knee).	• No baggy pants/jeans • No wind pants, side snaps or sweats will be allowed • No overalls • Pre-k-2nd grade may wear elastic waist bottoms • No blue jean skirts • No jogger style pants allowed. • Jeans must be blue in color. Slack/pants may be worn in khaki only. No other color will be allowed.
Shoes	• Shoes must be worn at all times. • Sandals must have a backstrap. • Shoes with laces must be tied.	• Crocs or similar in nature, shower flip flops, house shoes, stilettos, steel toed boots/shoes, sports cleats, and shoes with wheels are prohibited.
Hair	• Hair must be clean and neatly groomed and kept out of the eyes. • Boys' hair length must not touch the top of the polo shirt/dress shirt collar and fall below the middle of the ear or below the eyebrow. • Boys must be clean shaven daily. • No Man Buns	• No mohawks. • No indentations or designs on hair or eyebrows are allowed. • No unnatural hair coloring --- natural highlights are acceptable. Hair may not be dyed, streaked, or highlighted in any unnatural hair color(s) i.e. red, blue, green, pink, purple, etc. This includes, but is



		not limited to: braids, ponytails, weaves, wigs, beads, etc.
Jewelry Tattoos	- Earrings may be worn on the lobe of the ear (girls only). Males must remove all earrings and may not be covered. Unallowable earrings/piercings that are exposed will be CONFISCATED and assigned to ISS immediately.	- No decorative chains or chains on wallets. - No visible body piercings other than the lobe of the ear and no mouth jewelry. - No gauges. - No visible tattoos. (Must be covered at all times)
General	- School approved uniforms for physical education, athletics, pep rallies, etc., may be worn only during class or activity for which they are approved. - Backpacks must be clear or mesh only in grades 3rd-12th.	- No attire, belt buckles, hats, caps or other accessories with advertisement of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, weapons, drug paraphernalia, and/or derogatory nature on campus or school related activity. - No extreme or distracting makeup. - No face/body decorating with make-up, pens, markings or face paint. - No caps, hair nets, sweatbands, bandanas, sunglasses, or other head coverings may be worn indoors.
Special Events	- For unique or special events the campus administration will establish event specific dress code requirements and communicate with parents and students with sufficient notice. Long and mid-calf dresses are required if worn. - No revealing necklines or cleavage. - No strapless or spaghetti strap shirts/blouses.	- Awards Assemblies/Induction Ceremonies: Business formal attire required. - Banquets: Business casual attire required. - Prom: Appropriate formal attire for boys and girls.
Gang Related Attire	Items of this nature are strictly prohibited. This includes but, is not limited to: documented insignias, symbols, color combinations of clothing, hair styles/cuts, etc.	- No oversized necklaces, dog chains, etc. - No baggy pants/jeans or over-sized shirts. - No short pants worn with knee-high socks. - Pants worn low, or “sagging” and cuffed inside on the bottom are prohibited.
*Any dress wear, dress code item, hairstyle, or anything pertaining to grooming that at the discretion of a principal interferes, distracts, or disrupts the school environment is prohibited. *The above dress code applies to all extra curricular events, assemblies, and activities at school or at school sponsored events off-campus.
