Cathedral Family,

Well, I am watching out my window at the Christmas trees being removed. It feels sad. Yet, it is necessary to keep moving into the year God has given us-- Ordinary Time had begun. The Christmas season is to prepare us more fully to engage the full mission of Christ in our own lives and in the Church and world. The lighted trees were a remarkable witness to the Light of Christ. Thank you to all who memorialized trees for loved ones. The lights will be prepared for next year. We remain grateful to Costello-Runyan Funeral Home for their ongoing commitment of sponsoring our tree lights. The trees will now be ground into mulch and returned to local places to be used in parks and trails. But the Christmas mystery is to remain enlightening our vision to see our ordinary lives in a supernatural light.

This weekend we will recommission those who read the Word of God in the Liturgy. We know them as "Lectors," or more properly by their designated title of "Reader of the Word." We are blessed that week after week, at all of our Masses, we have men and women from our congregation who generously prioritize the schedule of preparing and proclaiming the Word of God in the gathering of the Church. It is a sacred moment. The Liturgy of the Church teaches us that when the Word is proclaimed in the Liturgy that the Reader "lends their voice to that of Christ Himself." It is Christ who is proclaimed and is the proclamation. The Scripture says that "faith comes through hearing." The proclaimed Word makes all the difference to strike our heart with the Holy Spirit when we hear it. A big encouragement of the Second Vatican Council was to have the lay faithful "prepare for Sunday by reading in advance and praying with the Sunday Scriptures." So, do you pray with the Sunday Scriptures? It is easy to find online. We are in Year B. Next Sunday will be the Third Sunday of the Year. Try it just once and see the difference your Sunday experience will become! Maybe spend some time with the family discussing what you think the readings mean beforehand. Then after Mass discuss on the car ride home what you learned about the readings. I encourage any people who may feel called to participate in our Ministry of Reader. You can let us know in the parish office. We are always in need of more Readers. I am very grateful to Mr. Boris Moczula who is the coordinator and trainer of our program. He will be delighted to inform you of the process of becoming a Reader of the Word of God at the liturgy. Please pray for our Readers that the Lord may bless their efforts and make their voice His own as they proclaim Him to our Assembly.

This Friday we will make our way to Washington, DC for the March for Life. Please join us! Contact Kara in the office. Our Mass will be at 6:30 am that morning. There will be no 7 am Mass on Friday, January 19th. This next Sunday January 21, at 12 noon, Bishop Checchio will celebrate the Mass in honor of Respect Life. Bishop has asked for nominees to honor from the parishes of the Diocese who have demonstrated exceptional commitment to the mission and cause of life. From our Cathedral of St. Francis parish---Christine Riggio will receive that honor. She has been a tireless witness for the cause of life. She works at Life Choices and is always ready to offer her assistance, prayers and support in regard to all efforts for life. Thank you Christine and may we all recommit ourselves to being people of life in an age that is growing darker with the shadows of death. May every life be loved and cherished from conception to natural death.

The Gospel today makes fresh the call of the disciples. The call is always serious business. As personal and direct as the Lord was with those first called, it is with each one of us. Our baptism is where it all began. This week, where is the Lord prompting you to go deeper? To allow more of your heart to be seen by Him? Christmas continues in our daily lives...
