

RESOLUTION

June 24, 2026

WHEREAS, the Kansas City Public Schools Board of Education works diligently, in partnership with the Administration, to steward taxpayer resources to advance educational achievement for students with Kansas City Public Schools (the “District”); and

WHEREAS, the District's resources to educate and support students and families have been threatened and impacted by actions taken or threatened at the federal, state, county and local level—including a projected shortfall following the Missouri legislature's failure to fully fund the foundation formula; and

WHEREAS, eliminating the Missouri state income tax will likely result in a future loss of resources for public education, estimated at \$1.4 billion statewide, with potentially significant consequences for public education, our students, and our families within the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kansas City Public Schools Board of Education hereby resolves to communicate our concern about the impending fiscal crisis for public education and its potential to compromise our capacity to support and maximize the educational potential of our students. Additionally, we ask the Superintendent to ensure that families and District stakeholders are kept aware of the potential financial impacts of these developments on our students and public education locally.

The Kansas City Public Schools' Board of Education speaks with one voice, which has been expressed through this Resolution.
