

**Regular Board Meeting
February 24, 2025**

The Leggett Independent School District Board of Trustees met in regular session on Monday, February 24, 2025, at 7:00 PM with the following Board Members present: Curtis Jefferson, Tommie Collins, Kevin Willson, Zach Johnson, and Daniel Goodman. Members not present were Armando Diosdado and Vicki Russell. Administrators present: Jana Lowe, Angela Sales, and Amanda Lawson.

The meeting was called to order by Curtis Jefferson at 7:00 PM.

The certification of public notice and the minutes for January 23, 2025, and January 27, 2025, Regular meeting was approved on a motion by Daniel Goodman. Tommie Collins offered a second. All members voted in favor of the motion.
