

**Regular Board Meeting
September 23, 2024**

The Leggett Independent School District Board of Trustees met in regular session on Monday, September 23, 2024, at 7:00 PM with the following Board Members present: Curtis Jefferson, Daniel Goodman, Kevin Willson, Robert Nowlin, Tommie Collins, Vicki Russell and Armando Diosdado. Administrators present: Jana Lowe, Angela Sales, Chief McDuffie and Amanda Lawson.

The meeting was called to order by Curtis Jefferson at 7:00 PM.

The certification of public notice and the minutes for September 5, 2024 Emergency meeting was approved on a motion by Daniel Goodman. Tommie Collins offered a second. All members voted in favor of the motion.

There was no citizen participation.

In the Administrator’s report, Ms. Lowe informed the board about the Leggett ISD cheerleaders participating in the Trunk or Treat on October 29th @ Pedigo Park.

In the Administrator’s report Mrs. Sales gave an update on the events that happened throughout the month of September at our school which includes, September 3rd Gold Day for Children’s Cancer, September 5th Grandparents Day for lunch, September 18th Picture Day, and September 19th Report Cards went out.

In the Administrator’s report, Mrs. Lawson informed the board that Leggett ISD currently has 96 students in 7th-12th grade. High School has added 1 student to the roster since last month. She also updated the board with Leggett Ag Science department applied for a National FFA Grant for Growing in March 2024. We found out in August that the Leggett AG department received the grant and was awarded \$4,600.00 to purchase CNC plasma table. This grant will allow students to practice new skills in the shop class that will benefit them in their careers later in life and offer new opportunities. Not only will students be able to create more professional projects, but they will also be able to learn software to create designs that can be cut on the plasma table. Many larger schools have the CNC software and machines, and we are very excited to be able to incorporate this into our program as well. She also added dates to remember for October. Progress Reports go home on October 3rd, SAT testing for 11th/12th grade on October 10th, No School- Columbus Day October 14th, Fall Festival October 25th from 6p-9p, ACT Testing 11th/ 12th grade and Trunk or Treat at Pedigo Park 4p-8p on October 29th.
