The Leggett Independent School District Board of Trustees met in regular session on Monday, May 19, 2025, at 7:00 PM with the following Board Members present: Curtis Jefferson, Tommie Collins, Kevin Willson, Daniel Goodman, Zach Johnson and Armando Diosdado. The meeting was called to order by Curtis Jefferson at 7:00 PM.
