

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS
October 28, 2024**

Nashville City Council met in regular session at noon on October 28, 2024. Mayor Larry Dunaway called the meeting to order. Nick Davis led in prayer and Police Chief Amy Marion led the pledge of allegiance.

Seven council members were present: Freddie Horne, Nick Davis, William Turley, Kay Gathright, Charles Pinkston, Herbert Turley, and Lynn Dyer.

Motion was made by William and seconded by Lynn to accept the minutes of the September 23rd meeting. Motion passed.

The financial report was given by the Finance Director Kimberly Green. Extraordinary expenses for September were: General Fund-Police- Police Canine Expense; \$21,546.00 for purchase of K9 paid to National K9 Training Center. General Fund-Park- Legion Hut Expense; \$11,500.00 for roof for Legion Hut paid to Langford Roofing & Construction. Franchise Fee Fund; Transfer to other account- \$11,500.00 transferred to pay for new legion hut roof. City sales tax decreased by 2.8% and county decreased by 6.7%. Motion by Freddie, second by Kay to accept the financial report. Motion passed. Kimberly presented Resolution 2024-14 ESTABLISH THE ELECTONIC TRANSFER OF FUNDS POLICY AND PROCEDURES. Resolution 2024-14 was read by City Clerk Hoen. Motion was made by Lynn to accept Resolution 2024-14, second by Herbert. Motion passed.

Meghan Floyd, Park Director reported starting November 1st the park will start putting out decorations for Christmas. Meghan talked about getting turf on fields 3 & 4 in the baseball complex.

Police Chief Amy Marion reported Greg Parker got back from training camp with the new K9 dog. Will bring him to the next meeting. Amy also reported still waiting on the grant to open for the computers.

Fire Chief Justin Thornton reported he did not have anything at this time.

David Riggs Code Enforcement Officer was not presented.

Public Works Director Larry Dunaway reported got approved for phase 1 for water project. The clarifier is underway. Got material bought, have the new troughs in and the old ones out. Dunaway presented a quote for the sidewalk project on S Main for phase 5. Wooster Construction Co., LLC was \$299,699.94, will owe about \$79,000 or around roughly Dunaway said. Motion to accept bid from Wooster by Nick, second by Herbert. Motion did not pass with 5 Yae's and 2 Nay's. Will table till next month.

Mayor Dunaway got a quote for \$22,000 for 26 panels that are out of services at the solar farm. Dunaway mentioned he does not have another quote and the panels do not have any warrant left. Will bring back next month.

Mayor Dunaway mentioned that December's meeting is on the 23rd, asked to move it up to the 16th. Budget meetings will be set for November 14th at 6 p.m. and December 10th at 6 p.m.

Resolution 2024-13 LEVY THE CITY MILLAGE FOR 2024 TO BE COLLECTED IN 2025. Resolution 2024-13 was read by Clerk Hoen. Motion made by Freddie to accept Resolution 2024-13, second by Nick. Motion passed.

Motion to adjourn by Herbert, second by Kay at 1:02.
