

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS
April 21, 2025**

Nashville City Council met in regular session at noon on April 21, 2025. Mayor Larry Dunaway called the meeting to order. Brent Thompson led in prayer and Police Chief Amy Marion led the pledge of allegiance.

Eleven council members were present: Freddie Horne, Donna Harwell, Brent Thompson, Phil Jones, Vivian Wright, William Turley, Kay Gathright, Charles Pinkston, Herbert Turley, Lynn Dyer, and Joe Hoen coming in late.

Motion was made by Donna and seconded by Vivian to accept the minutes of the March 24th meeting. Motion passed.

The financial report was given by the Finance Director Kimberly Green. Extraordinary expenses for March were: Street-Capital Outlay: \$55,500.00 for work done on Dodson Creek Bridge, ARDOT, KFC, and Johnson St. paid to Wooster Construction. Wastewater-Capital Outlay: \$52,300.00 for WWTP improvement payment #6 paid to RBIS, \$89,400.00 for WWTP clarifier new trough supports payment #1 & clarifier new mechanism rebuild payment #2 paid to RBIS. Franchise-Transfer to Other Funds: \$34,837.00 transferred to Water & Sewer Capital Reserve Savings to payback for transfer for street aid paving. City sales tax decreased by 5.85% and county decreased by 5.65%. Motion by Freddie, second by William to accept the financial report. Motion passed.

Meghan Floyd, Park Director presented Tiera Jones for the empty spot of the park commission. Freddie made to accept Jones for the park commission, second by Brent. Motion passed. Floyd mentioned the park is still in baseball season. The easter egg hunt at the park went well, stuffed over 8,000 eggs, and placed them out.

Police Chief Amy Marion reported she did not have anything at this time. The MILO machine is here and running.

Fire Chief Justin Thornton reported he did not have anything at this time.

David Riggs Code Enforcement Officer reported he has a few structures he has sent information out to. Ordinance 995 and 996 Peddlers Permit was presented. Discussion was made about the changes added to the ordinance. Ordinance 995 was read by Mayor Dunaway. Motion was made by Donna to put Ord. 995 on its final reading, second by Vivian. Motion passed. Mayor Dunaway read Ord. 995 by Title. Motion was made by Donna to accept Ordinance 995, second by Brent. With 9 Yae's and 2 Nay's, Motion passed.

Public Works Director Larry Dunaway presented Resolution 2025-06 Utilize Federal-Aid Transportation was read by Dunaway. Discussion was made. Motion was made by Joe to accept Resolution 2025-06, second by Donna. Motion passed. Dunaway mentioned the water project is still going.

Motion to adjourn by William, second by Brent at 1:01.
