

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS
September 22nd, 2025**

Nashville City Council met in regular session at noon on September 22, 2025. Mayor Larry Dunaway called the meeting to order. Brent Thompson led in prayer and Police Chief Amy Marion led the pledge of allegiance.

Eleven council members were present: Freddie Horne, Donna Harwell, Brent Thompson, Phil Jones, Vivian Wright, William Turley, Kay Gathright, Charles Pinkston, Herbert Turley, Kathy Combs, and Lynn dyer.

Motion was made by William and seconded by Kay to accept the minutes of the August 25th meeting. Motion passed.

The financial report was given by the Finance Director Kimberly Green. Extraordinary expenses for August were: General Admin- Equipment Replacement: \$37,746.00 for 2025 Dodge Durango for police department paid to York Gary. Wastewater- Purification: \$73,412.00 for ACH paid to Water Tech. City sales tax decreased by 2% and county increased by 16%. Motion by Donna, second by Freddie to accept the financial report. Motion passed.

Meghan Floyd, Park Director reported she did not have anything at this time. Meghan did mention Golden Gathering will be October 9th from 9-12, also Trunk or Treat in the park will be on October 30th.

Police Chief Amy Marion presented an update on the in-car computers. Amy mentioned they are still waiting on some supplies.

Fire Chief Justin Thornton reported he did not have anything at this time.

David Riggs Code Enforcement Officer was not presented. Larry mentioned he is working on some properties and annexation and will bring at a later time.

Seborn Gregory Animal Control Officer presented an update on the Animal Control truck and how it was in the shop. Seborn also presented he wanted to make some changes to Ordinance 906, and talked about some changes that need to be made. Will bring back at a later date.

Public Works Director Larry Dunaway presented an update on the water plant project. Larry also mentioned the stop signs on 2nd St. going North and South and still have stop signs going East and West. Charles Pinkston said we need to make it where medical emergencies vehicles do not have to stop. Discussion was made. Larry mentioned he would talk to Pafford and go from there.

John Hearnberger spoke for SWA Paws. John introduced the group and what their propose is. They also presented adoption numbers. They also suggested some changes to the Animal Control interlocal agreement which was tabled for further discussion. Some questions were asked which Jenna Millwood Pope spoke and answered the questions. Larry mentioned he is getting a meeting together for Wednesday with all the Animal Control Mayors. Larry will get the recommendations from the other Mayor's and will bring back to the council members.
