

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS
December 16, 2024**

Nashville City Council met in regular session at noon on December 16, 2024. Mayor Larry Dunaway called the meeting to order. Nick Davis led in prayer and Police Chief Amy Marion led the pledge of allegiance.

Nine council members were present: Freddie Horne, Joe Hoen, Donna Harwell, Nick Davis, William Turley, Charles Pinkston, Herbert Turley, Kathy Combs, and Lynn Dyer.

Motion was made by Joe and seconded by Donna to accept the minutes of the November 25th meeting. Motion passed.

The financial report was given by the Finance Director Kimberly Green. Extraordinary expenses for November were: Street-Misc. Expense: \$141,531.56 for backhoe purchase paid to Riggs CAT. Franchise: \$2,100.00 transferred to street for operating expense, \$550.00 transferred to animal control for operating expense. City sales tax increased by 6% and county increased by 2%. Motion by Donna, second by Kathy to accept the financial report. Motion passed.

Meghan Floyd, Park Director reported she did not have anything at this time.

Police Chief Amy Marion reported shop with a cop/fire fighters went great, had 76 kids go shopping. Amy also mentioned she applied for a grant last year for a milo machine which is a virtual reality training system, and she did get the grant.

Fire Chief Justin Thornton reported he did not have anything at this time.

David Riggs Code Enforcement Officer reported he did not have anything at this time.

Public Works Director Larry Dunaway reported updates on the water treatment plant, water tank and the south main sidewalk project. Larry presented pictures of a 2007 Mack CV7 dump truck that the Reginal Solid Waste Agency has for sale for \$33,000.00. Motion was made by Freddie to purchase the dump truck, second by Nick. Motion passed. Resolution 2024-15 To Utilize State Aid Street Monies was read by Larry. Motion by Donna to accepted Resolution 2024-15 second by Kathy. Motion passed.

Resolution 2024-16 Adopt of Operating Budget for 2025 was read by City Clerk Lauren Hoen. Motion was made by Freddie to accept Resolution 2024-16 second by William. Motion passed.

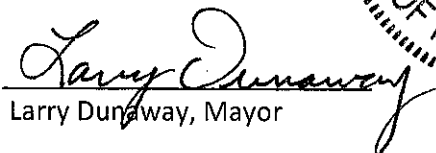
Larry presented Nick Davis with a 20-year appreciation plaque for his service on the council.
