

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS
September 23, 2024**

Nashville City Council met in regular session at noon on September 23, 2024. Mayor Larry Dunaway called the meeting to order. Nick Davis led in prayer and Police Chief Amy Marion led the pledge of allegiance.

Ten council members were present: Freddie Horne, Donna Harwell, Nick Davis, Phil Jones, William Turley, Kay Gathright, Charles Pinkston, Herbert Turley, Kathy Combs, and Lynn Dyer.

Motion was made by William and seconded by Kathy to accept the minutes of the August 26th meeting. Motion passed.

The financial report was given by the Finance Director Kimberly Green. There were no extraordinary expenses for August. City sales tax increased by 1% and county decreased by 18.6%. Motion by Freddie, second by Donna to accept the financial report. Motion passed.

Meghan Floyd, Park Director reported events happening in the park. The flag football jamboree will be October 5th and a softball tournament going on the same weekend. On October 8th the high school and junior high cross country will have their track meet in the park, October 10th will be the Golden gathering, October 19th a softball tournament, and October 31st will be Halloween in the park. Meghan also reported the pickle ball courts also finally finished.

Police Chief Amy Marion reported Greg Parker will be leaving on October 12th for training with the new K-9 dog. On the gun auction the city made \$9,600.00. Amy also reported still waiting on the grant to open for the computers.

Fire Chief Justin Thornton reported he did not have anything at this time.

David Riggs Code Enforcement Officer reported he did not have anything at this time.

Public Works Director Larry Dunaway presented a letter from Civil Engineering Associated, LLC. There was a bid from RBIS, LLC for \$292,000.00 and needed a resolution to accept the bid. Resolution 2024-12 Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to accept the bid, was read by City Clerk Hoen. Motion was made by Nick, second by Donna to accept Resolution 2024-12. Motion passed. Mayor Dunaway talked about future manhole rehabilitation project.
