

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS
May 19, 2025**

Nashville City Council met in regular session at noon on May 19th 2025. Mayor Larry Dunaway called the meeting to order. Brent Thompson led in prayer and Mayor Larry Dunaway led the pledge of allegiance.

Ten council members were present: Donna Harwell, Brent Thompson, Phil Jones, Vivian Wright, William Turley, Kay Gathright, Charles Pinkston, Herbert Turley, Kathy Combs, and Lynn Dyer.

Motion was made by William and seconded by Donna to accept the minutes of the April 21st meeting. Motion passed.

The financial report was given by the Finance Director Kimberly Green. Extraordinary expenses for April were: Franchise- Transfer to Other Funds: \$5,000.00 transferred to animal control for operating expense, \$19,364.00 transferred to street for state aid street paving change order. City sales tax decreased by 3% and county decreased by 4.8%. Motion by Donna, second by Kathy to accept the financial report. Motion passed.

Meghan Floyd, Park Director reported she did not have anything at this time.

Police Chief Amy Marion reported she did not have anything at this time.

Fire Chief Justin Thornton reported he did not have anything at this time.

David Riggs Code Enforcement Officer reported he sent a letter to the owner of the 2-story blue house on 4th St. He talked to Larry & David and is working on the weekends to fix it up, has 120 days to do so. David also sent a letter to the Old Sunset Grocery Store, she agreed to tear down, Tony Fatherree has been the accepted bidder to tear down.

Public Works Director Larry Dunaway reported Resolution 2025-07 Confirming the City's Intent to Issue Bonds, was read by Larry. Motion was made by Donna to accept Resolution 2025-07. Second by Vivian. Motion passed. Larry also mentioned the stripping for Pope St. & 7th St. will be done this week, and will ask if they could do Cassidy St & crosswalks in town, so will cost a little more.

Larry asked if June's meeting can get moved to the 30th. Everyone agreed to move June's meeting to the 30th.

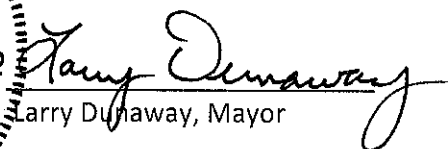
