

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS
October 27th, 2025**

Nashville City Council met in regular session at noon on October 27, 2025. Mayor Larry Dunaway called the meeting to order. Brent Thompson led in prayer and Police Chief Amy Marion led the pledge of allegiance.

Twelve council members were present: Freddie Horne, Joe Hoen, Donna Harwell, Brent Thompson, Phil Jones, Vivian Wright, Kay Gathright, Charles Pinkston, Herbert Turley, Kathy Combs, Lynn Dyer.

Motion was made by William and seconded by Vivian to accept the minutes of the September 22nd meeting. Motion passed.

The financial report was given by the Finance Director Kimberly Green. Extraordinary expenses for September were: Street-Capital Outlay: \$28,829.00 for 2021 Chevrolet Silverado paid to York Gary. Public Works Admin-Capital Outlay-Water Plant Expansion: \$38,000.00 for professional services rendered for 2025 revenue bond paid to Friday, Eldredge, & Clark, \$611,484.00 for engineering fees paid to Civil Engineering. Franchise Fee-Transfer to other funds: \$40,829.00 transferred to street to pay for truck and other operating expense. City sales tax increased by 4% and county decreased by 6%. Motion by Donna, second by Joe to accept the financial report. Motion passed.

Meghan Floyd, Park Director reported to consider charging non-league people a fee to use the lights at the city park. Discussion was made. Meghan mentioned she will bring a quote next month for the conversion to led lights.

Police Chief Amy Marion reported she did not have anything at this time.

Fire Chief Justin Thornton reported he did not have anything at this time.

David Riggs Code Enforcement Officer reported he did not have anything at this time.

Public Works Director Larry Dunaway presented Resolution 2025-11 City Millage. Resolution 2025-11 was by Larry. Motion by Joe to accept Resolution 2025-11, second by Donna. Motion passed. Larry mentioned he is still waiting on one more grant from the engineers for the Water Plant Project. We have gotten the revise drawings and should be able to move forward soon. Also still working with Southwest Planning for the Wastewater Plant Clarifier that went out, will keep everyone updated.

Joe Hoen brought up the redlight on Main St. that is not working. Larry mentioned it got hit by lighting during a storm. Larry said it would cost \$60,000.00 to \$70,000.00 or more to fix it. Motion by Joe to take the red light down, second by William. Motion passed. Stop signs will be put up on East and West side of the intersection.

Ordinance 997 Fire Relief & Pension Fund was read by Larry. Motion by Donna to suspend the rules and put Ord. 997 on its final reading, second by Kathy. Motion passed. Larry read Ord. 997 by title. Motion by Donna to accept Ord. 997, second by Brent. Motion passed.

Deb Young with SWA Paws spoke about updates with their program. She also mentioned that SWA Paws fundraiser will be on October 18th. Larry mentioned that interviews for an animal control officer will be for Wednesday and Thursday of this week.

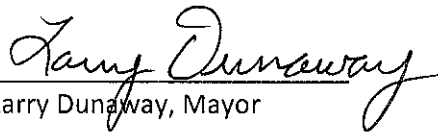
