

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS
June 24, 2024**

Nashville City Council met in regular session at noon on June 24, 2024. Mayor Larry Dunaway called the meeting to order. Nick Davis led in prayer and Police Chief Amy Marion led the pledge of allegiance.

Ten council members were present: Joe Hoen, Donna Harwell, Nick Davis, Phil Jones, Vivian Wright, William Turley, Kay Gathright, Charles Pinkston, Herbert Turley, and Kathy Combs.

Motion was made by Donna and seconded by Kathy to accept the minutes of the May 20nd meeting. All in favor. Motion passed.

The financial report was given by Finance Director Kimberly Green. Extraordinary expenses for May were: General-Admin misc. exp.; \$34,950.00 for courtroom & library water damage repair paid to Branch Construction (received insurance check from Municipal League to cover costs). General-Admin solar interest & principal; \$135,537.53 for annual solar payment paid to First Security Finance. City sales tax increased by 4.7% and county decreased by 1%. Motion by Donna, second by Vivian to accept the financial report. Motion passed.

Meghan Floyd, Park Director reported they have got rewarded the Heritage grant for the Legion Hut. She needs an official vote for her to sent a financial report saying we have the \$10,000 for the grant. Motion was made by Donna to accept Meghan getting a financial report for the grant, second by Herbert. Motion passed.

Amy Marion, Police Chief reported she did not have anything.

Justin Thornton, Fire Chief reported he did not have anything.

David Riggs, Code Enforcement Officer he did not have anything.

Public Works Director Larry Dunaway presented Resolution 2024-07 Federal-Aid Transportation Alternatives Program Funds. Resolution 2024-07 was read by City Clerk Lauren Hoen. Motion was made by Joe to accept Resolution 2024-07, second by Vivian. Motion passed.

Mayor Dunaway presented the City of Nashville personnel policy to the council. Mayor Dunaway went over the policy and mentioned some changes. Council will look over and vote at a later time.
