

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE  
CITY OF NASHVILLE, ARKANSAS  
December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

Nashville City Council met in regular session at noon on December 15, 2025. Mayor Larry Dunaway called the meeting to order. Brent Thompson led in prayer and Police Chief Amy Marion led the pledge of allegiance.

Eleven council members were present: Freddie Horne, Joe Hoen, Donna Harwell, Brent Thompson, Phil Jones, Vivian Wright, William Turley, Charles Pinkston, Herbert Turley, Kathy Combs, and Lynn Dyer.

Motion was made by Donna and seconded by William to accept the minutes of the November 24th meeting. Motion passed.

The financial report was given by the Finance Director Kimberly Green. Extraordinary expenses for November were: Police-Annual CAD/Software Maintenance: \$29,500.00 for iSOMS Software one-time initial setup, install, data conversion paid to M & M Micro Systems, Inc.; Grant Expenditures: \$50,688.54 for grant for laptops for police cars paid to Turn-Key Mobile, Inc. Franchise Fee-Transfer to other funds: \$5,500.00 transferred to street for operating expenses. City sales tax decreased by 8.7% and county decreased by 5%. Motion by Donna, second by Vivian to accept the financial report. Motion passed.

Meghan Floyd, Park Director reported she did not have anything at this time.

Police Chief Amy Marion reported shop with a cop had 75 kids and \$16,000.00 raised. Amy mentioned all the computers and the equipment are in the cars.

Fire Chief Justin Thornton reported he did not have anything at this time.

David Riggs Code Enforcement Officer reported he did not have anything at this time.

Public Works Director Larry Dunaway reported that everything is still going good.

Motion made by Donna to accept the emergency clause of Ordinance 999, second by Kathy. Motion passed.

Mayor Dunaway presented Ordinance 998 Interlocal Agreement regarding District Court. Ord. 998 was read by Mayor Dunaway. Discussion was made. Motion was made by Donna to suspend the rules and place Ord. 998 on its final reading, second by Vivian. Motion passed. Mayor Dunaway read Ord. 998 by title. Motion by Joe to accept Ord. 998, second by Donna. Motion passed.

City Clerk Clements presented Resolution 2025-12 Adopt of Operating Budget for 2026. Resolution 2025-12 was read by City Clerk Clements. Motion made by Donna to accept Resolution 2025-12, second by William. Motion passed.

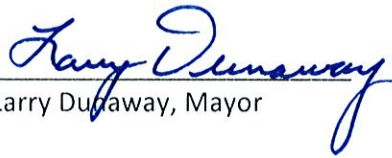
