- SUMMER MATH HOURS -

1 STEP INTO THE ARENA

Log in: Sign in to your IXL account.
Navigate: Click on the Diagnostic tab at the top of your dashboard.
Launch: Click the "Step into the arena" button.

2 ANSWER QUESTIONS

Choose your path: Pick the question that looks most interesting to you.
Don't stress: This isn't a graded test – it shows what you know and what to work on.
Use "I don't know this yet": Skip brand-new concepts to help IXL find your accurate level.



3 COMPLETE THE ASSESSMENT

Fill the stars: Answer questions until the computer gathers enough data (about 30-40 minutes total).
Take breaks: The diagnostic saves your progress – no need to do it all at once!

Using IXL Diagnostic Arena during the summer is an excellent strategy to combat the "summer slide." This tool accurately assesses your knowledge levels in math, automatically creating a tailored action plan for skills to practice.

USE YOUR PERSONALIZED ACTION PLAN

Once your levels are set, IXL highlights skills on your Recommendations wall. Work on these for 9 minutes per day to maintain your academic levels all summer long!

Suggested schedule:

- **Monday – Thursday:** Spend 8-9 minutes a day working on your IXL Diagnostic Action Plan skills.

- **Weekend:** Take the weekends completely off.
