The City of Hanceville, Alabama met in a public session on June 11th, 2026, for a work session beginning at 6:00 PM in the council chambers of city hall with the meeting immediately following.

Mayor Nolan Bradford called the meeting to order at 6:08 PM.

City Attorney, Dan Willingham led the prayer and Mayor Bradford followed with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Bradford opened the floor for public comments.

Kimberly Love, who lives on Cagle street stated she started a petition because she had spoken with Nolan the mayor about these issues the weeds, sludge in the waterways and dredging the waterways, she stated ' I am sorry but anything will work when it comes to dredging our waterways because the mud is crazy, the weeds the water is not flowing it is getting backed up it at least needs to flow somewhere when they dredge just her house it now sets in front of her neighbor's house and when pipe went it was still not taken care of" . The people mowing the sidewalks needs education on how to take care of sidewalks you don't mow them you weed eat them, use edger or kill the weeds.

Mayor Bradford explained they have been talking about this and there is a lot of infrastructure that needs to be fixed some of the pipes are the wrong size, some maybe running up hill. Mayor Bradford agreed to get Rusty to work on this.

Pam Reed chairperson Hanceville historic preservation committee, and a member of the daughters of American Revolution Dripping Springs Chapter she announced a dedication of a statue of a minuteman on July 3rd @10:00 AM at Sportsman Lake, she handed out invitation for council and attorney.

Dan Davis stated he needed to share something with council, Dan J. Willingham and everyone listening on you tube he stated " I am adult survival of childhood domestic violence " I was married to abusive wife for 32 years, he proceeded to explaining he made a report with Officer Cody Allen Kelsoe but he was not helpful at all. Mr. Davis continues to explain he had to pay Willingham and Fuller Attorney \$3500 for a PFA. Mr. Davis complaint

is he could not get any help from Hanceville police and should not have had to pay a go between.

Councilor Brown motioned for City of Hanceville to host a "America's 250 Community Celebration" for July 25th, 2026, with a \$15,000.00 budget. Mayor Pro Tem Shelton seconded. Motion carried.

Councilor Powell motioned to appoint Councilor Kim Brown as alternate emergency check signer. Mayor Pro Tem Shelton seconded. Motion carried. (Councilor Kim Brown abstained herself from the vote).

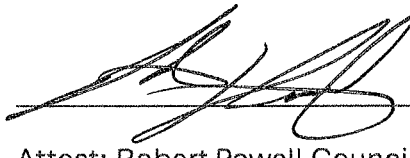

The City Council of Hanceville, Alabama met in public session on June 25, 2026, at 6:00 P.M. in the City Hall.

Mayor Nolan Bradford called the meeting to order.
Prayer was led by Ty Watwood.
Mayor Bradford led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Bradford opened the floor for public comments.

Kimberly Love addressed council to thank public works for cleaning up the street she lives on. Mayor Bradford stated the rain, and flooding was a major factor in the condition of the city streets.

Mr. Charles Wilson of 409 Commercial St SE approached the podium with questions and concerns about waterlines need to be upgraded to allow for fire hydrants. Sewer verses septic tanks, and that the one lane gravel road needs to be widened to two lanes. Public hearing closed at 6:20 pm.

Councilor Powell talked about the 250th anniversary celebration and Hanceville's 150th anniversary in 2029.

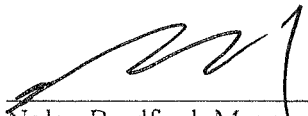

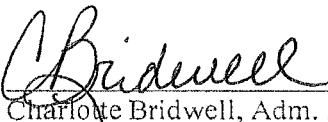
