REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
4/9/2026

The City Council of Hanceville, Alabama, met in public session on April 9, 2026, for a work session beginning at 6:00 PM in the council chambers of city hall with the council meeting immediately following.

Mayor Nolan Bradford called the meeting to order.

City Attorney, Dan Willingham led the prayer and Mayor Bradford followed with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Bradford opened the floor for public comments.

Mr. Clifton, who lives on the side of highway thirty-one by Cabin Fever, addressed the Council with concern regarding trucks parking on the side of HWY 31; there's a lot of banging, dumping trailers, it's very loud at various hours. He stated his main concern, because they have a baby on the way, was the loud noise at night and hoped the council could get something done. Mayor Bradford responded, letting him know they would look into it.

Councilor Brown motioned to approve the *consent agenda*. Councilor Shelton gave second. Motion carried.

Councilor Rowe motioned to approve the *minutes* for the Regular Council Meeting held on March 26, 2026. Seconded by Councilor Shelton. Motion carried.

Councilor Powell moved to pay the *bills*. Councilor Rowe seconded. Motion carried.

Councilor Brown motioned to approve the garbage bags (PALS). Seconded by Councilor Shelton. Motion carried.

Councilor Brown motioned to request *bids* for fencing for all five fields, bids to be turned in by April 30th. Councilor Rowe gave second. Motion carried.

Councilor Rowe motioned to get that fixed (*Commercial ST Bridge*). Councilor Powell motioned in second. Motion carried.

Bridge repair quote in the amount \$26,800 submitted by Rusty Fields from Glasgow & Riddle Engineering and Inspections, LLC.

City received insurance proceeds in the amount of \$25,800 for repair.

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Councilor Rowe motioned to approve *Jarvis Recreation Management* for the park and also for all of our other systems. Seconded by Councilor Powell. Motion carried.

Councilor Brown moved to partner with the Army Corps of Engineers for a *Feasibility Study* on Mud Creek. Councilor Rowe gave second. Motion carried.

Motion given by Councilor Rowe to approve the public works inventory for *surplus* and all the 1033 be allocated back to the 1033:

Councilor Brown motioned to continue with the *Future Foundation Scholarship Fund*. Councilor Powell gave second. Motion carried.

Councilor Brown moved to *close* Commercial, Bangor, Blountsville, Church and *waive peddler fees* (Grilled Cheese Festival May 23rd). Seconded by Councilor Rowe. Motion carried.

Councilor Powell motioned to table *Phone System*. Seconded by Councilor Brown. Motion carried.

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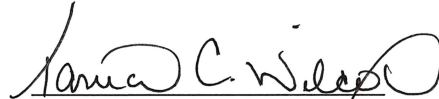
