

HEALTH POLICY

The state law requires the following for every student in preschool, kindergarten, 2nd, and 6th grade.

Preschool – is required to have a physical exam with current immunization record along with a lead screening before school begins.

Kindergarten – must have a dental exam, vision exam (by a licensed optometrist or ophthalmologist), and physical exam with current immunization record.

2nd grader – must have a dental exam.

6th grader – must have a dental exam, and physical exam with current immunization records.

(The immunization requirement must also be met. Students not meeting these requirements will be granted one week (5 days) to schedule an appointment or have the necessary examination and/or immunizations. After five days, a student will be suspended *due to lack of compliance*. *Children age 6 and under entering school must comply with a lead screening/testing requirements before beginning school.*)

Students participating in interscholastic sports/athletics are required to have a new physical each year. Group physicals will be set up by the athletic director for those students intending to participate in any interscholastic sport for the year. Physical examinations must be completed before a student can participate.
