I wanted to let all the current 6th grade parents know of the immunization requirements for the next school year of 2026-2027. The school system is required to have an updated Immunization Form #3231 on file for all 7th graders because they are required to have vaccinations for (Tdap), and Meningococcal (MCV4). This policy is set forth in policy guide 3231 *REQ, Vaccine Requirements for Attending Facilities and Schools in Georgia*. It will be necessary for parents to take their children to either their primary care provider or local health department for the vaccinations.

If parents do not want to get their child vaccinated, which I do not suggest, then a (DPH form 2208) Affidavit of Religious Objections to Immunizations needs to be filled out. This form is provided by the Georgia Department of Public Health and will need to be signed by parents and notarized. The completed form needs to be brought to the school nurse and will be placed in the student's file.

The Schley County School System is audited by the local health department each fall to make sure we are in compliance with this law. If your child already has these vaccinations and you have an Immunization Form #3231 that has the 7th grade or higher block checked, then your child has met this requirement. I am able to access this information on the GRITS System.
