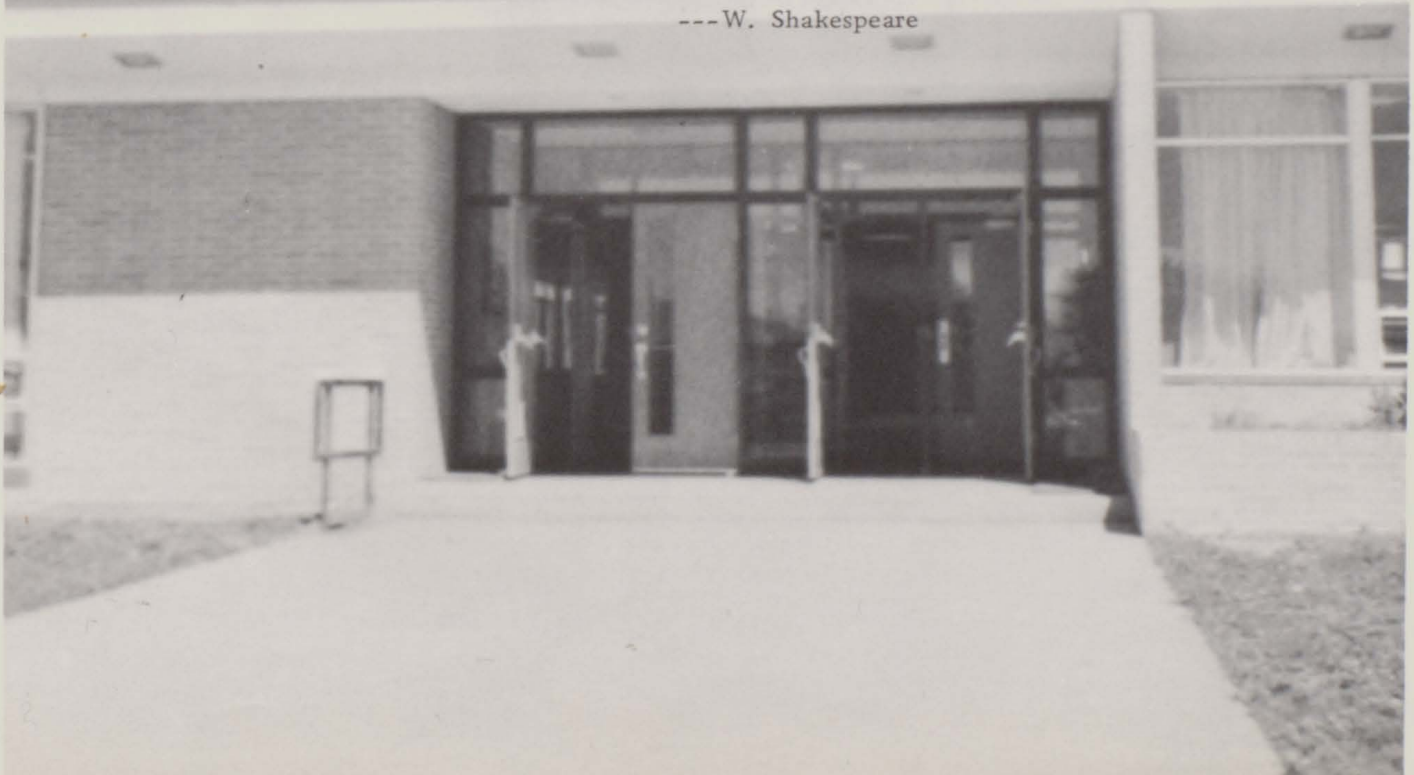
When to the sessions of sweet silent thought

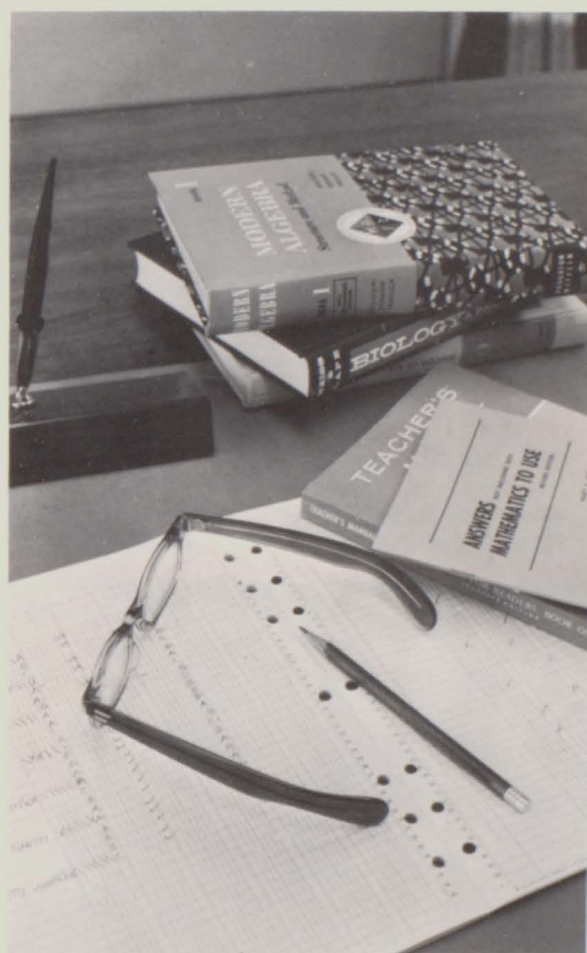
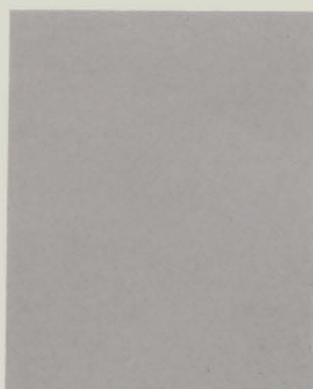
We, the class of 1970, dedicate our annual to a missing friend and classmate, Patsy Gutzmann, who was fatally injured in an auto accident during our sophomore year.

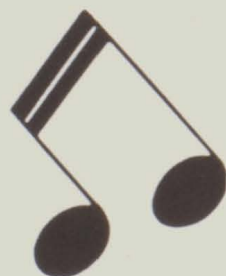

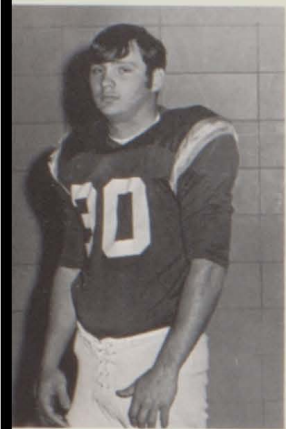
