## Graduation is Goal #1

The Foundation High School Program (Distinguished Diploma) requires the student to earn an **Endorsement** and to have **26 credits** to graduate. Of those 26 credits:

- **4 credits** are required in **English-Language Arts** (including English I & II)
- **4 credits** are required in **Math** (including Algebra I and Geometry)
- **4 credits** are required in **Science** (including Biology and a lab science)
- **3 credits** are required in **Social Studies** (including US History, half credit of Govt and half credit of Economics)
- **1 credit** is required of **Physical Education**
- **1 credit** is required of **Fine Arts**
- **2 credits** are required of the same **Foreign Language**
- **7 credits** are required of **electives** (most can be selected from core subjects or career/technology classes)

IN ORDER TO EARN A DISTINGUISHED DIPLOMA AND TO BE IDENTIFIED BY THE STATE AS "COLLEGE, CAREER OR MILITARY READY", THE STUDENT MUST TAKE AT LEAST THREE COURSES FOR AT LEAST 4 CREDITS (WITH ONE COURSE BEING A LEVEL 3 OR LEVEL 4 COURSE) IN A SINGLE PROGRAM OF STUDY AND EARN AN IBC (INDUSTRY-BASED CERTIFICATION) IN THAT FIELD.

### Robotics & Automation Tech (GWAMA)

Machinery (Robotics) will transfer academic skills to component designs in a project-based environment through implementation of the design process. Students will build prototypes or use simulation software to test their designs.

The Nursing Science program of study introduces students to the knowledge and skills related to patient care. Students may learn about or practice caring for patients, routine procedures such as monitoring vital signs, development plans, psychopharmacology, disease or pain management.

### Graphic Design and Interactive Media

The Graphic Design and Interactive Media program of study focuses on occupational and educational opportunities associated with designing or creating graphics to meet specific commercial or promotional needs, such as packaging, displays, or logos. The program of study includes designing clothing and accessories and creating special effects, animation, or other visual images using film, video, computers, or other electronic tools and media for use in computer games, movies, music videos, and commercials.

### WELDING (GWAMA)

The Welding program of study focuses on planning, managing, and performing the processing of materials into intermediate and final products and related professional and technical support activities.

### CONSTRUCTION (GWAMA)

The Carpentry program of study provides students with skills such as constructing, installing, or repairing structures and fixtures made of wood, such as concrete forms (including frameworks, partitions, joists, studding, rafters, and stairways.)

### Agricultural Technology and mechanical systems

The Applied Agriculture Engineering program of study involves applying knowledge of engineering technology and biological science to agricultural problems concerned with power and machinery, electrification, structures, soil & water conservation, and processing agricultural products. They also study the diagnosing, repairing/overhauling farm machinery, tractors, harvesters, etc. This involves welding. IBCs include:

### BUSINESS MANAGEMENT

The Business Management program of study teaches CTE learners how to plan, direct, and coordinate the administrative operations of an organization. They also learn to formulate policies, manage daily operations and allocate the use of materials and human resources. IBCs include:
